














STEAMtastic Saturdays

We focus on interdisciplinary, project-based learning centered on STEAM during Saturday workshops called STEAMtastic Saturdays.













Miami Norland Senior High School built a Tetrix Robot and competed for the first time in Norland's History.










Coretta Scott King Young Women Leadership Academy Atlanta, Georgia

Girls in grades 6th-8th learned how to navigate different types of drones using obstacle courses.








STEAMtastic Saturdays
