CURRENT PROGRAMS & DESCRIPTIONS



FIRST LEGO LEAGUE	Elementary competition with Legos in Lego in League. Includes building, coding and competition
FIRST TECH CHALLENGE	Code, Design, and Compete with Robots after school Teams design, build, and code robots to compete in an alliance format against other teams. -FIRST
FIRST ROBOTICS	FIRST Robotics Competition gives high school students and their adult mentors the opportunity to work and create together to solve a common problem. -FIRST
VIRTUAL DRONES AT HOME	Teams design, build, and code virtual drone to compete throughout the world.
STEAMTASTIC SATURDAY	Students and community stakeholders come together to build STEM products for other communities' usage
F1 IN SCHOOLS	Students learn how to build and print cars using Autodesk, CAD, and CNC Router; racecars using carbon dioxide, and have the option to compete internationally

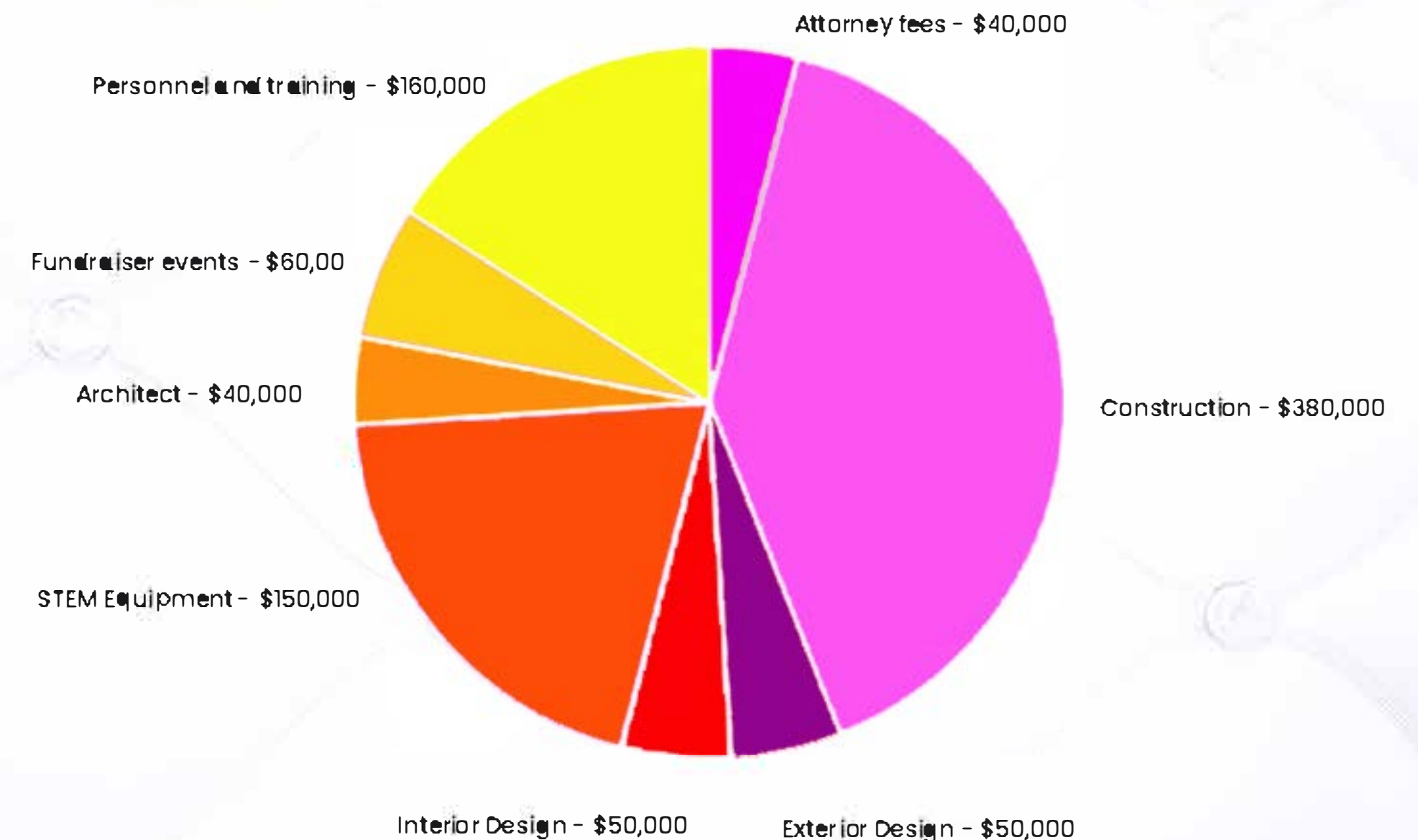
